#### **Report Highlights:**

**Export refunds were set for the period March-May 2003. All export refunds for fresh produce decreased except for tomatoes. Export refunds for processed products remained unchanged.**

## Export Refunds for Fruit and vegetables (5<sup>th</sup> period of 8<sup>th</sup> GATT year)

All export refund rates decreased except for tomatoes: the refund rate for tomatoes remained unchanged; the refund rate for oranges decreased from 22 EUR to 21 EUR; for lemons from 22 EUR to 18 EUR and for apples from 12 EUR to 10 EUR.
