Report Highlights:

On March 9, 2004, the Philippine Department of Agriculture (DA) through Memorandum No. 15 temporarily banned poultry imports from the State of Maryland due to a confirmed outbreak of avian influenza in the state. The order became effective on February 15, 2004

The Philippine Department of Agriculture (DA) has temporarily banned imports of poultry and poultry products from the State of Maryland due to a confirmed outbreak of avian influenza. The DA had already banned all imports of domesticated and wild birds and their products including poultry meat, day-old chicks, eggs and semen from the states of Delaware, Pennsylvania and Texas and other Asian countries due to confirmed outbreaks of avian influenza.

The ban was made formal by DA Memorandum Order 15, dated March 09, 2004 and became effective on March 15, 2004.

So far, there is no reported incidence of avian influenza in the Philippines.
