



# U.S. Production of Cherries





# **U.S. Cherry Production Climbs; While Fresh Consumption & Processing Expands, Exports Slow**





# Washington and Oregon Accounts for Approximately 65 Percent of the U.S. Sweet Cherry Crop



# U.S. Cherry Imports and Market Share of Domestic Consumption




# U.S. Fresh Cherry Prices

# Asian Markets Boost U.S. Exports of Fresh Sweet Cherries to Record High 2001





# The Value of Fresh Cherry Exports Reaches a Record High




# The U.S. Leads the World in Cherry Exports

# Chile Remains the Dominant Supplier of Cherries to the U.S. Market


