

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Report

May 2019

The May WASDE report shows FY 2019 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 121,254 short tons raw value (STRV), up 22,046 STRV from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The FY 2020 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 99,208 STRV. No information is available about specific countries.

The fifth and last tranche of the FY 2019 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 35,000 metric tons raw value on Wednesday, July 17, 2019. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
