

# **U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports**

**Fiscal Year (FY) 2022**

**May 2022**

The May WASDE report shows FY 2022 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 70,548 short tons raw value (STRV), down 159,625 STRV from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The fifth tranche of the FY 2022 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 40,000 metric tons raw value on July 15, 2022. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
