

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2024

March 2024

The March WASDE report shows FY 2024 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 91,776 short tons raw value (STRV), unchanged from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

On March 7, USDA increased the FY2024 WTO raw sugar TRQ by 125,000 metric tons raw value (MTRV). USTR will allocate the TRQ increase among supplying countries.

The fourth tranche of the FY 2024 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 40,000 metric tons raw value on April 15, 2024. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
