

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2025

February 2025

The February WASDE report shows FY 2025 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 189,922 short tons raw value (STRV), up 95,862 STRV from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The fourth tranche of the FY 2025 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 45,000 metric tons raw value on April 14, 2025. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
