



# Oilseeds: World Markets and Trade


## Soybean Trade Remains Strong While Product Exports Contract

In 2022/23, soybean trade is forecast well-above last year, owing mostly to record Brazil production and strong global demand. While import demand has plummeted in markets like Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Egypt, this is mostly offset by growth in markets including Argentina and China. Argentina is forecast to have the largest growth in 2022/23 as crushers look to supplement waning domestic production with imports from other South American producers, especially Brazil and Paraguay.



Conversely, global trade of soybean meal and oil is forecast lower. The drought in Argentina is the primary driver, constricting crush and production of soybean meal and oil in the world's largest exporting country of both. For soybean meal, global 2022/23 imports are forecast 4.2 million tons lower than the previous marketing year to the lowest level in 6 years. Soybean meal imports are down in most countries, but the biggest drops are in the Middle East, Southeast Asia, and the European Union. Meal exports are forecast up from Brazil and the United States; however, supplies will be insufficient to entirely offset the losses in Argentina. Importers are expected to increase purchases of soybeans and other substitutable protein meals like rapeseed and sunflowerseed meal.

For soybean oil, imports are forecast to be the lowest in 5 years driven by lower Argentina exportable supplies and strong U.S. renewable diesel production, which has rendered U.S. soybean oil export prices uncompetitive on the global market. Soybean oil trade is further dampened by the announcement that the Brazil biodiesel blend mandate has been raised to 12 percent, putting further pressure on exportable supplies. As a result of tighter global exportable supplies and higher industrial consumption,




soybean oil as a percentage of global vegetable oil consumption is forecast to fall below 30 percent in 2022/23 for the first time in nearly a decade. Despite lower soybean oil food use, global vegetable oil

food consumption is forecast up in 2022/23 on gains in palm, rapeseed, and sunflowerseed oil consumption.

## MARKET FEATURE

### EU Rapeseed Trade and Consumption Rebounds to Record Levels in 2022/23

The European Union is projected to import, crush, and consume record volumes of rapeseed this year. Imports are forecast at 6.7 million tons, 30 percent higher than the previous 5-year average. Demand for rapeseed in the EU has long outpaced domestic production following several years of drought and the 2018 ban on neonicotinoid pesticides, with harvested area decreasing nearly 10 percent since the policy was enacted. While EU domestic rapeseed production is expected to rebound in 2022/23, global exportable supplies are also up decidedly, with total production nearly 20 percent higher than last year. A record crop in Australia (the EU's main rapeseed supplier) and increased rapeseed exports from Ukraine suggest that the EU will capture more than a third of global rapeseed trade in 2022/23.



Demand for protein meal has recently driven more of the rapeseed crush value in the EU given the reduction of exportable soybean meal supplies in Argentina. Prices for rapeseed meal have continued to trade at a discount compared to soybean meal since last spring, with the discount increasing since the beginning of the calendar year. EU rapeseed oil prices also dropped below palm oil prices for the first time in 2 decades in March, encouraging an increased share of rapeseed oil feedstock in biofuel production and providing an alternative option for food consumption.

## DATA SERIES REVISIONS AND PSD DATABASE ADDITIONS

### Palm Oil Data Revisions

The PSD database includes a country group called “Other” which is only used for the palm oil commodity. “Other” palm oil trade has been revised this month for 2009/10 through 2022/23 to use reported and derived data for the relevant countries. The countries included in “Other” are: Armenia, Bahrain, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Brunei Darussalam, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cambodia, Comoros, Congo B, East Timor, Equatorial Guinea, Fiji, Gabon, Gambia, Georgia, Guinea-Bissau, Guyana, Jamaica, Kosovo, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Lebanon, North Macedonia, Madagascar, Malawi, Maldives, Mali, Marshall Is, Martinique, Mauritius, Moldova, Mongolia, Namibia, Niger, Qatar, Samoa (W), Seychelles, Solomon Is, Somalia, Suriname, Syria, Tajikistan, Trinidad & Tobago, Turkmenistan, Tuvalu, Uganda, Uzbekistan, Vanuatu, and Zambia.

### Philippines Palm Oil and Palm Kernel Data Revision

Philippines palm oil and palm kernel seed production has been revised for 2010/11 through 2022/23 to align with data from Philippines Statistical Authority (PSA). Consumption and ending stocks were adjusted to reflect the changed production attribute.

### Bangladesh Rapeseed Production Revision

Bangladesh rapeseed production has been revised for 2001/02 through 2022/23 to reflect data from the Bangladesh Department of Agriculture Extension. Domestic crush was adjusted in line with rapeseed production changes.


### Paraguay Cottonseed Production Revision

Paraguay cottonseed production has been revised for 2010/11 through 2022/23 to adopt official statistics from the Paraguay Ministry of Agriculture for cotton and cottonseed. Domestic crush was adjusted in line with cottonseed production changes.

### Soybean Meal Country Additions

As of this publication, USDA’s Production Supply and Distribution database has been expanded to include soybean meal balance sheets for Azerbaijan, Cambodia, and Cote d’Ivoire starting in marketing year 2013/14. The three countries are forecast to import a combined 485,000 tons of soybeans in 2022/23 (Oct-Sep). These additions account for much of the change in the soybean meal trade balance this month.

## OVERVIEW 2022/23

Global oilseed production is lowered 4.5 million tons to 625 million on reduced Argentina and Uruguay soybean crops due to continued deterioration from drought conditions, with some mitigation coming from Brazil soybeans. Oilseed trade is little changed from the previous month with Uruguay soybean export reductions mostly offset by increases from Canada and Ukraine. However, meal exports are down 2 million tons on lowered Argentina exports. Global production of meal is down 3 million tons on lower Argentina and Bangladesh soybean meal. Production of oil is little changed with reductions in soybean oil from Argentina offset by higher rapeseed oil from Bangladesh. Oil exports are little changed. The projected U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$14.30 per bushel.


## EXPORT PRICES

Average soybean prices were lower in March for all major exporters in anticipation of the impending record Brazil harvest. Brazil prices fell the most, increasing the discount versus other exporters. Following a several-month trend, global soybean export prices were also pressured downward by soybean oil prices amidst ample supplies of other vegetable oils as crush margins were less attractive for processors. As of the beginning of April, South America soybean oil is trading at a premium to palm oil. Soybean meal prices were also lower on average this month for the first time since December.



### SOYBEAN MEAL EXPORT PRICES




