


Grain: World Markets and Trade

China Purchases Large Volumes of U.S. Wheat, Diversifies Import Origins

China 2023/24 (July/June) wheat imports are forecast up this month by 500,000 tons to 12.5 million, driven by large recent purchases from the United States. Though imports are still slightly below the prior year, China has solidified its position as the world's top importer for the second year in a row.


On a calendar year (CY) basis, China has already imported 10.7 million tons through October, indicating it will exceed the 9.36-million-ton tariff rate quota (TRQ) by a significant margin. Although China imported more than the wheat TRQ amount in both 2021 and 2022, this is the first calendar year it will import over 10.0 million tons since 1995.

The United States has lost significant market share in China over the past decade due to uncompetitive prices and stiff competition from Australia, Canada, and the European Union (EU). However, since June, total commitments of U.S. wheat to China have surpassed 2.0 million tons, boosted by strong recent sales of Soft Red Winter (SRW) wheat. Ample supplies of SRW this year have pushed prices down, making the class competitive against Australian and French origins.

China's demand for international wheat has been bolstered by quality concerns in its domestic crop this year, mostly due to heavy rains at harvest time in top wheat-producing province Henan. Ample domestic supplies of feed-quality wheat have resulted in larger



expected wheat feed and residual use in 2023/24, up 4.0 million tons from the previous year, as Chinese feed mills are augmenting feed rations with lower quality and sprouted wheat. With a greater proportion of feed-quality wheat in this year's crop, China requires additional imports of milling wheat to supplement domestic supplies for food use.

Last year, China relied on Australia's ample supplies of both milling and feed-quality wheat. Given a record 2022/23 crop and lower shipping costs to China, Australia exported a record 7.8 million tons of wheat to China in the last trade year, capturing nearly 60 percent market share. So far this trade year (Jul-Oct), China wheat imports from Australia are down 27 percent from the same period last year. Australia's smaller 2023/24 crop, which was harvested beginning in October, has severely curtailed exportable supplies for the coming year.

Limited Australian supplies are prompting China to import wheat from other origins. In addition to expanded purchases from the United States, imports from Canada are up 37 percent, indicating stronger demand for milling wheat. China has also resumed imports from Kazakhstan in large volumes. Kazakhstan typically exports small volumes of wheat to China, partially due to challenges meeting importer specifications. This year, however, Kazakhstan has already shipped 300,000 tons of wheat to China, compared to



near-zero exports over the same period last year. The growth of the Alashankou rail border station and China's transportation subsidy when shipping commodities to inland areas have helped expand shipments through the Chinese-Kazakh border. China wheat imports from Russia, meanwhile, are nearly at a record only 4 months into 2023/24. China lifted restrictions on Russia wheat imports last year and trade has expanded rapidly since then. Future expansion in trade seems plausible since Russian exporter EPT signed an agreement in October to export 70.0 million tons of grains, oilseeds, and legumes to China over 12 years. Russia offers price competitive milling wheat compared to U.S. or Canadian origins.


WHEAT

OVERVIEW FOR 2023/24

Global production is forecast up this month, though it remains below last year's record. Both Australia and Canada production estimates are raised but are still down 37 percent and 7 percent from the prior year, respectively. Despite upward revisions this month for exports from the United States, Australia, Canada, and Ukraine, global trade is still forecast below last year's record with each of those exporters forecast to have lower exports than the prior year. Imports are forecast up this month for the European Union and China. Record global consumption is adjusted even higher this month. Global stocks are raised fractionally higher this month, but still at the lowest level since 2015/16. The U.S. season-average farm price is up 10 cents per bushel to \$7.30.

WHEAT PRICES

<u>Domestic</u>: U.S. quotes have risen since the November *WASDE*. Soft Red Winter (SRW) increased the most, up \$17 to \$273/ton, with strong demand from China as reflected in recent USDA *Export Sales* reports with several daily announcements of large sales. SRW sales to China have more than quadrupled from the same period last year amid improved competitiveness. HRW prices rose \$5 to \$294/ton reflecting sales to China and strengthening cash prices. Hard Red Spring (HRS) was up \$2 to \$318/ton amid robust shipments to various Asian markets. Soft White Wheat (SWW) was virtually unchanged, down only \$1 to \$273/ton.



Global: Major exporter quotes have been mixed since the November WASDE. The most competitively priced wheat is from Russia, despite an increase of \$13/ton as unfavorable weather hampered exports. EU quotes eased by only \$1/ton. The most dramatic shift was a steep decline in Argentine quotes which were down by \$41/ton as the harvest has commenced with a larger crop than the prior year. Australia is the other Southern Hemisphere exporter with an ongoing harvest, but significantly smaller production there is one reason that export quotes are nearly unchanged since last month. Canadian quotes were also unchanged from last month. U.S. quotes had eased throughout the past month, but strong recent sales to China have buoyed quotes \$5/ton higher.



RICE

OVERVIEW FOR 2023/24

Global rice production is forecast higher this month mainly on a larger crop in Thailand. Global consumption is forecast down slightly with less consumption in several Sub-Saharan African countries offsetting an increase in India. Imports are forecast down, primarily driven by reductions for China, Kenya, and Nepal. Exports are forecast lower, mostly due to a sharp decrease for India.


RICE PRICES



In the past month, U.S. export quotes rose by \$5 to \$765/ton, while Uruguayan quotes jumped \$30 to \$790/ton due to strong demand and tight supplies. For the first time since 2019, Uruguayan quotes surpassed the United States. Vietnamese quotes showed a slight increase of \$11 to \$687/ton with continued demand from the Philippines and Indonesia. Thai rice quotes rose by \$51 to \$619/ton on increased demand particularly from countries previously supplied by India and a stronger currency. Fast-rising Thai prices bring export quotes to within \$68/ton of regional competitor Vietnam, a significant change from a month ago when Vietnamese export quotes were \$121/ton more than Thai rice. Pakistani quotes were up by \$39 to \$589/ton as harvest pressure was offset by strong demand. Export quotes for India white rice have been unavailable since imposition of an export ban for milled white rice on July 20.

MARKET FEATURE

Pakistan Rice Exports Forecast at a Record High



Over the past several months, Pakistan rice export prices have escalated sharply to the highest level in over 15 years. Fortunately, Pakistan is harvesting a bumper 2023/24 rice crop, estimated up 62 percent from last year to 9.0 million tons. With larger exportable supplies and only a marginal increase forecast in domestic consumption, Pakistan is forecast to export a record 5.0 million tons in 2023/24. Pakistan has emerged as the most price competitive supplier that stands to gain market share in many price-sensitive markets in 2024.

India's export restrictions have enabled Pakistan exports to flourish. Over the past several years, India was the most affordable supplier of rice on the global market. In September 2022, India banned exports of broken rice, after which Pakistan was able to ship more, particularly to China, a large importer of broken rice. When India banned exports of non-parboiled non-basmati white rice in July, Pakistan had limited supplies available for export from its 2022/23 crop. However, with the onset of the harvest in October, Pakistan has already begun to ship remarkably higher volumes. Other major white rice exporters, including Thailand and Vietnam, are supplying Southeast Asian importers such as the Philippines and Indonesia, leaving opportunities for Pakistan in Africa and other regions typically supplied by India.

More than half of Pakistan rice exports are non-basmati white rice. Pakistan's largest markets so far this year have been Kenya, Tanzania, and Malaysia. While Pakistan will seek to expand exports to traditional markets this year, it will likely pursue new growth in markets previously supplied by India. Pakistan's reach will even extend to the Western Hemisphere; so far this year, Haiti – a core U.S. market – has imported more than 100,000 tons from Pakistan.

In addition, Pakistan exports a large amount of basmati rice, a fragrant rice that sells at a premium. Exports are largely destined to the Middle East, Europe, and North America. India is the only competitor for this type of rice and has not banned exports of basmati rice, so Pakistan may face some challenges expanding market share for this variety.

COARSE GRAINS

OVERVIEW FOR 2023/24

Global corn production is forecast up slightly, with larger crops in Ukraine, Russia, the European Union, and Egypt more than offsetting cuts to Mexico and Canada. Global trade is forecast up, primarily on higher exports from Ukraine and the United States. Global imports are also forecast higher, led by an increase in Mexico, as well as several countries within Central America and North Africa. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$4.85 per bushel.



Since the November *WASDE*, bids for all major exporters have increased. U.S. bids were \$213/ton, up \$1 from last month. Record production in the United States and easing Mississippi river shipping costs are moderating prices, despite a recent surge in sales to Mexico and Japan. Brazilian bids were \$230/ton, up \$11 from last month. Sustained demand for Brazil corn, particularly from China, and logistics challenges through northern export routes are keeping reported bids at a small premium. Argentine bids were \$220/ton, up \$9 from last month. Higher prices largely reflect movements in other export markets, with bids quiet ahead of the December 10 inauguration of Argentina's new president, and the potential impact of proposed economic policy changes on agricultural markets. Ukrainian bids have not been published since July 21.


For the first time ever, Brazil corn exports to Japan surpassed the United States in overall volume in 2022/23, with Japan importing 6.9 million tons of corn from Brazil. In contrast, U.S. exports to Japan dropped to just under 6.9 million tons, a nearly 2.9-million ton drop year over year (-31 percent). U.S. market share in Japan declined to just 46 percent versus the average of 75 percent over the previous 9 years. This was only the second time in the past 20 years that the United States accounted for less than 50-percent market share in Japan. The last time U.S. market share sunk to a similar level was 2012/13, when severe drought slashed U.S. production from the prior year.

Over the past 4 years, Japan ranked as the fourth-largest corn importer in the world. In dollar terms, U.S. corn trade to Japan is worth around \$2.4 billion on average, around 20 percent of the value of U.S. corn exports to the world each year.

Headwinds for U.S. corn are partially attributable to broader trends in Japan's corn import market in 2022/23. Japan imports declined as record global corn prices pushed buyers towards substitutes. For much of 2022/23, domestically produced feed rice was price competitive with imported corn supplies. As a result, the ratio of corn in feed rations declined from an average of 48 percent during the prior 5 years to 45 percent in 2022/23.

In addition, overall corn imports are dampened by a weakening yen. Policy efforts by the Bank of Japan resulted in the Japanese yen falling against the U.S. dollar – with the real effective exchange rate dropping to 74.31 in July 2023– the lowest rate recorded by Japan since the 1970s. As a result, Japan's import costs are set to remain well above historical averages.

However, most of the shift in Japan's corn market is attributable to competition from Brazil. Japan imports most of its corn from either the United States or Brazil and switches sourcing between each seasonally based on price. Logistics challenges in the United States between October and December 2022, and tighter than usual supplies in the United States resulted in a significant price wedge that favored Brazil during 2022/23. This wedge reached a high of \$40/ton in April 2023 when landed values averaged approximately \$330/ton from Brazil versus \$370/ton from the United States.



Early season data suggests that the U.S. market share should rebound in 2023/24. U.S. export bids at Pacific Northwest ports, the major route for U.S. corn exports to Japan, versus Brazil have narrowed to just \$5/ton as of December 2023, versus a \$40 spread in December 2022. Additionally, Export Sales Reporting data indicates total sales and shipments of U.S. corn to Japan stand at 3.6 million tons as of November 30, compared to 1.4 million tons in 2022/23, and 13 percent higher than the 5-year average of 3.2 million tons.

<u>Marketing Years (MY):</u> MY refers to the 12-month period at the onset of the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's MY for that commodity (2022/23 starts in 2022); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the MY (2022/23 starts in 2023). <u>Prices</u>: Many export bids and quotes in this publication are Free-On Board (FOB). FOB is a term of sale meaning that the shipper will pay all costs to deliver and load the cargo at a specified place, usually a ship, and then the receiver pays the costs from there on — normally the ocean freight and all subsequent costs of unloading and delivery.

<u>Stocks:</u> Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

<u>Consumption:</u> World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

<u>Trade</u>: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year (TY 2022/23 corresponds to Jan – Dec 2023).

EU Consolidation:

Effective January 1, 2021, the separation of the United Kingdom (UK) from the European Union (EU) was complete, including trade between both entities. Starting in May 2021 with the release of 2021/22 data, field crops PSDs reflect EU27 (shown in the PSD system as "European Union") and UK separately.

Beginning with the release of 2021/22 data, historical data for both EU27 and the UK are provided for 5 years (2016/17 through 2020/21). The trade figures starting from 1999/00 through 2015/16 represents the European Union (EU27 plus UK) and excludes all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria, Romania, and Croatia, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat (1001), flour (1101), bulgur (190430), and selected pasta products (190219, 190230, and 190240) on a grain-equivalent basis (all wheat flour and products are multiplied by 1.368). (2) Rice trade statistics include rough (100610), brown (100620), milled (100630), and broken (100640) on a milled-equivalent basis (rough rice is multiplied by 0.7 and brown rice is multiplied by 0.875). (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

<u>Unaccounted:</u> This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
