


# Oilseeds: World Markets and Trade

## Plummeting Argentina Soybean Production Impacts Global Soybean and Products Trade



For the third straight month, 2022/23 Argentina soybean production is lowered as hot and dry weather continues to strain the crop in key growing regions. This month, production is down 8.0 million tons to a 14-year low of 33.0 million. Likewise, crush is forecast at the lowest level in over a decade. Plummeting Argentina supplies and crush will have implications on global trade of soybeans, protein meal, and vegetable oils over the coming months.


To help offset tight domestic soybean supplies, Argentina imports (Oct-Sep) are forecast to be a record at 7.3 million tons. Argentina importers are expected to capitalize on a record Brazilian crop and recovery in Paraguay production to supplement the weak domestic crop. As a result, Argentina is expected to have the second-largest spike in soybean import growth in 2022/23, behind China.

For soybean products, overall trade is forecast down this month. Global soybean meal trade is down more than 1.0 million tons from last month as tight Argentina supplies support already high prices and shift some demand into other protein meals. Likewise, global soybean oil trade is down more than 2 percent this month as high Argentine and U.S. prices shift demand to palm oil, rapeseed oil, and sunflowerseed oil. Partly offsetting lower exportable supplies from Argentina, Brazil soybean oil exports are up this month and forecast just below last year's record. However, the Government of Brazil is scheduled to meet in March to decide the mandatory biodiesel blend rate which currently sits at 10 percent. If the blend rate is raised, then exportable supplies could be lower. This would further push up soybean oil prices and cause importers to rely more heavily on other vegetable oils.

## MARKET FEATURES

### Vietnam Soybean and Soybean Meal Imports Continue to Grow in 2023

A combination of a growing GDP, an increasing population, and a shift to more protein-rich diets have contributed to Vietnam's expanding livestock and aquaculture industry and need for imported feedstuffs. Consequently, Vietnam soybean meal imports have grown steadily since the early 2000s. With projected imports at 5.3 million tons, Vietnam is the world's third largest soybean meal importer, trailing only the EU and Indonesia. After opening domestic soybean crush facilities in 2011, Vietnam has emerged as a major destination for soybeans with imports projected at over 2.0 million tons in 2023.




manufacturers are more reliant on imports to satisfy the domestic demand for protein meal. Historically, Argentina has been the main supplier of soybean meal to Vietnam, leaving both the United States and Brazil with lower market shares.

In 2022, Argentina was the main supplier of soybean meal with 65-percent market share, followed by Brazil (25 percent) and the United States (7 percent). While U.S. 5-year average market share remains at approximately 8 percent, marketing years that face significant declines in Argentina supplies represent opportunities for other exporters to increase market share. Back in 2017/18, during a significant drought and with tight exportable supplies in Argentina, the United States recorded a significant increase in soybean meal exports to Vietnam, rising its share to 16 percent.

Looking at soybeans, Brazil and the United States are Vietnam's principal suppliers. In 2022, Vietnam imported nearly 1.9 million tons of soybeans with Brazil's share at 54 percent, followed by the United States at 37 percent. Over the last several years, the U.S. market share of soybean exports to Vietnam has declined from an average of over 50 percent, as Brazil and other more price competitive suppliers capitalize on Vietnam consumption gains.

Vietnam's feed demand is driven by increased pork production, growing from 1.0 million tons in 2000 to 2.7 million in 2022, while chicken meat production quadrupled over that same period. Additionally, aquaculture continues to increase and is another driver of feed demand as a growing population seeks additional protein sources and international markets continue to increase demand for Vietnam-sourced seafood products.

## **Overview of PSD Series Revisions**

### **Uruguay – Soybean Production**

Uruguay soybean production is revised for 2009/10 through 2022/23. USDA has implemented a new methodology for calculating Uruguay soybean production based on findings during recent meetings with industry contacts in Uruguay. USDA now uses planted area estimates from UruPov, a company that collects information from farmers who purchase seeds (certified and saved seeds) to track the use of GE technology for royalty purposes in Uruguay. As a result, total supply in Uruguay is revised up for most years on larger area harvested. Additional supplies lead to slightly higher crush and significantly increased feed waste domestic consumption that now includes a more accurate estimate for seed plantings and full-fat feeding for the poultry industry.

### **Paraguay – Soybean Production and Disappearance**

Paraguay soybean production is revised for 2011/12 through 2022/23. Estimates are revised to reflect market information received from La Cámara Paraguaya de Procesadores de Oleaginosas y Cereales (CAPPY). In years where there is not enough soybean supply to meet export, consumption, and ending stock demand estimates, a negative residual is added to soybean feed, seed, and waste to adjust the balance sheet. These negative residuals are likely the result of an underestimated crop and/or missing unreported imports with surrounding countries.

### **Costa Rica – Palm Kernel Seed and Palm Oil Production**

Costa Rica palm kernel and palm oil production has been updated for 1999/00 through 2020/21. These changes were based on Costa Rica palm production and products data from the Ministry of Agriculture.

### **Thailand Copra Production and Domestic Disappearance**

Thailand copra production series have been revised for 2010/11 through 2022/23 based on Thailand's Office of Industrial Economics official data for coconut oil production. USDA adopted a new methodology to derive copra production from provided coconut oil production. Accordingly, Thailand's copra crush, meal and oil production, and domestic disappearance were adjusted in line with the production changes.

### **Sri Lanka Copra Production and Domestic Disappearance**

Sri Lanka copra production series have been revised for 1999/00 through 2021/22 based on Ministry of Agriculture official data for coconut oil production. USDA adopted a new methodology to derive copra production from provided coconut oil production. Additionally, Sri Lanka's copra crush, meal and oil production, and domestic disappearance were adjusted in line with the production changes.

## OVERVIEW 2022/23

Global oilseed production is lowered 7 million tons to 630 million predominantly on large reductions to Argentina soybean and sunflowerseed and India cottonseed crops. These changes are only partially offset by increases to the Australia and Ukraine rapeseed crops. Oilseed trade is increased with higher volumes of soybeans from the United States and Brazil, rapeseed from Ukraine and Australia, as well as cottonseed from Australia. However, global production and trade of protein meals are down, reduced mainly on Argentina soybean meal and India cottonseed meal. Despite overall reduced crush, total oil production is little changed overall in part due to increased palm oil. Oil trade is raised slightly on higher Turkey, Russia, and Ukraine sunflowerseed oil and Malaysia palm oil, partially offset by lower soybean oil trade. Global ending stocks of oilseeds, meal, and oil are all lowered notably. The projected U.S. season-average farm price for soybeans is unchanged at \$14.30/bu.

## EXPORT PRICES


Since the February WASDE, average soybean prices were slightly higher as crop conditions and export expectations in Argentina continued to deteriorate. Soybean meal prices surged for all exporters in February driven by crop concerns and declining crush in Argentina, leading to the highest Argentina soybean meal prices in over 10 years. Global meal supplies and prices may face volatility in the coming months depending on the uncertainty of Argentina harvest, policy, and crush.

February soybean oil export prices were lower than the previous month. U.S. prices continued a downward trend from the announcement of lower-than-expected proposed biofuel targets by the Environmental Protection Agency in December coupled with higher imports of rapeseed oil from Canada for use as feedstock. However, U.S. prices remained significantly more expensive than South America. The discount between soybean oil and palm oil narrowed as average palm oil prices remained relatively unchanged in the face of slow exports from Indonesia and increased competition from sunflowerseed oil. Going forward, soybean oil prices are likely to moderate on increased competition from other vegetable oils and the harvest progress in Brazil.




