

**Annual Status Report  
Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) for Farmers Program  
Fiscal Year 2010**

Section 293 of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2401b), as amended by Section 1884 of the ARRA, requires USDA to provide a report annually containing the following information: a list of the agricultural commodities covered by a certification under the law; the states or regions in which such commodities are produced and the aggregate amount of such commodities produced in each state or region; the total number of agricultural commodity producers, by congressional district, receiving benefits under the law; and the total number of agricultural commodity producers, by congressional district, receiving technical assistance under the law. *\* Under the Fiscal Year 2010 TAA for Farmers Program, 4,450 agricultural commodity producers were approved for technical training and cash benefits. As of December 22, 2010, 96 percent of approved producers have completed the first of four technical training phases of the program. Producers who complete the first three training phases, including the completion of an initial business plan, will be eligible to receive \$4,000 in cash benefits. Producers who complete the final training phase, including the completion of a long-term business plan, will be eligible to receive an additional \$8,000 in cash benefits.*
